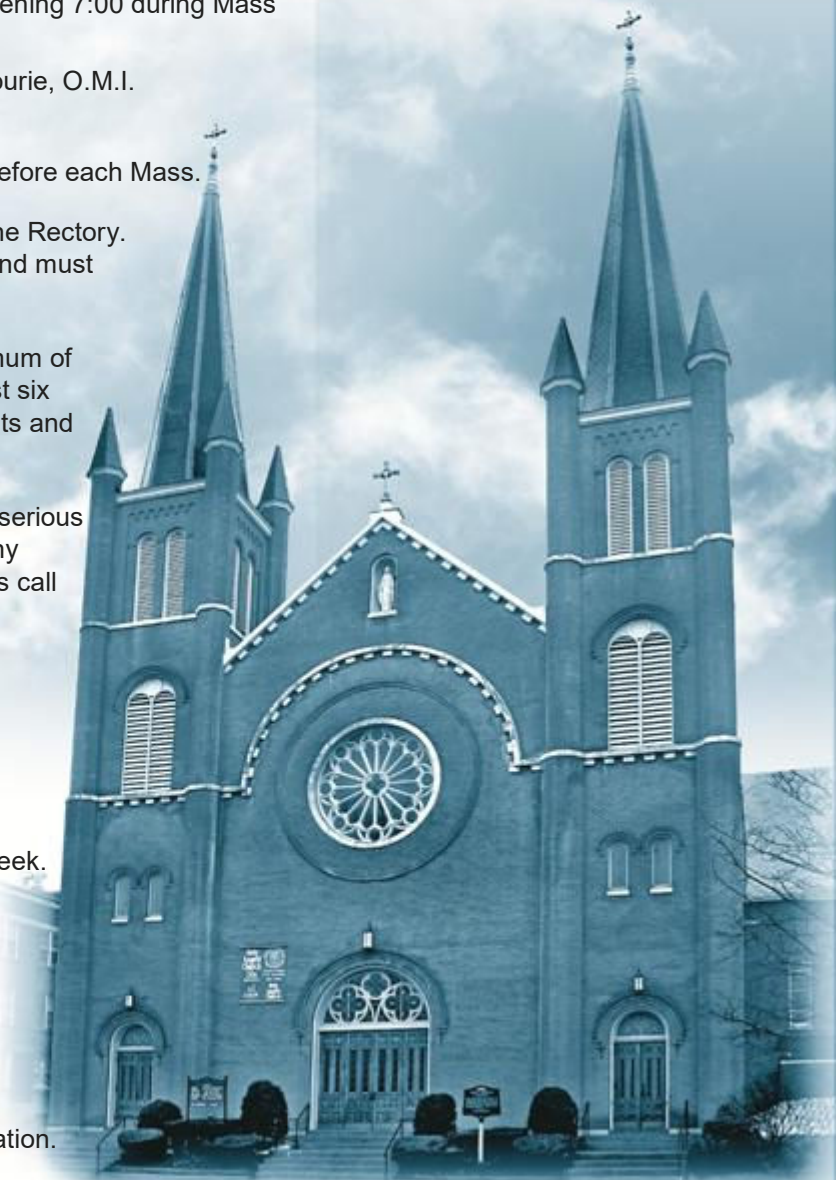

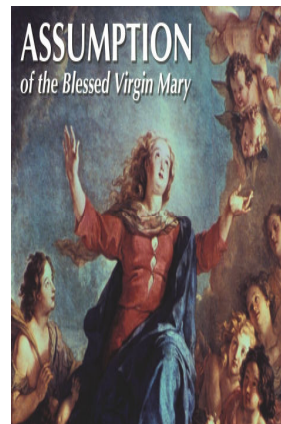
Cardinal Francis Xavier Nguyen Van Thuan was a Modern example of Christian witness in the 1970's when he was coadjutor Archbishop of Saigon, Vietnam he was arrested by the communists for his faith. After he was freed he would write a small book called "Five Loaves and Two Fish" in which he recalls some of his experiences In prison He writes that he didn't have much to offer Jesus in prison, but he gave all that he did have. Today's Gospel message is the familiar five loaves and two fish. But this is more than just another one of Jesus miracle stories. The key to understanding it is in today's second reading from St.Paul to the Romans. What will separate us from the love of God? We often find ourselves spiritually hungry, longing for God's presence due to anguish, distress, peril, persecution. But this is when God multiplies the little that we have and fills us with his abundant presence. So if you are spiritually hungry, or thirsty, listen to Isaiah "Come to the water...come receive grain and eat". If the burdens of life have left have the pantry of your spirit with very little, don't be afraid to bring it to Jesus. Cardinal Van Thuan an important lesson for us: don't curse the emptiness and darkness letting it make you bitter. Rather live in joy, love and forgiveness and God will fill you with abundant blessing.

El Cardenal Francisco Xavier Nguyen Van Thuan fue un ejemplo modern de testimonio Cristiano. En los anos de 1970 cuando fue Arzobispo coadjutor de Seigon, fue arrestado por los comunistas por su fe. Despues de ser liberado escribio un libro titulado Cinco Panes y Dos Peces en el cual recuerda su experiencia en la prision, Escribe que no tenia mucho para ofrecerle a Jesus en la prision, pero y dos peces.. Pero esto es mucho mas que otra de los cuentos milagrosos de Jesus. La clave para comprenderlo se encuentra en la segunda lectura de hoy de San Pablo a los Romanos. Que nos separara del amor de Dios. Muchas veces nos separara de amor de Dios a causa de la angustia, tribulacion, peligro, persecucion. Pero es entonces cuando Dios multiplica lo poco que tenes hambre o sed espiritual, escucha lo que dice Isaias Vengan por agua...vengan, tomen trigo y coman. Si las angustias de la vida han dejado la despensa de tu espiritu con muy poco, no tengas miedo de traerselo a Jesus. El Cardenal Van Thuan es una leccion importante para nosotros no maldigas el vacio y la oscuridad dejandro que te amarguen. En vez, vive con gonzo, amor y el perdon.Entonces Dios te llenara con bendiciones abundantes.

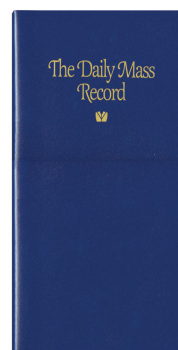
